

Greenwood doing community relations for MTR Gaming

CHESTER, W.Va.—Former Pittsburgh Steeler L.C. Greenwood is becoming a community relations consultant for MTR Gaming Group Inc.

He and fellow businessman Donald Duffy are quitting the board of directors, but MTR declined Tuesday to release their resignation letters.

Spokeswoman Tamara Pettit could not say when Greenwood will start, what his work will focus on, or what he'll be paid.

Greenwood, a board member since 2002, was a defensive end and key part of Pittsburgh's "Steel Curtain" defenses from 1969 to 1981.

Duffy has a communications consulting firm and Pettit says he needs to spend more time with his clients.

MTR owns and operates Mountaineer Casino, Racetrack & Resort in Chester, Presque Isle Downs & Casino in Erie, Pa., and Scioto Downs in Columbus, Ohio.
